NOTE: EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2013, ALL PACKAGES MAY ONLY BE RECEIVED FROM AN APPROVED VENDOR

Only the items and amounts listed will be permitted. ALL ITEMS MUST BE IN FACTORY SEALED CONTAINERS AND REQUIRE

NO REFRIGERATION, COOKING OR MICROWAVING. Items packaged in contraband containers will not be accepted. All acceptable incoming items will be inspected. All incoming packages must have the patient's name and AT number. The unit number of the patient (if known) is helpful to further ensure proper and timely delivery.

◆Package size may not be any more than 30 lbs. and/or 24L x 19W x 12H inches◆

Incoming packages are limited to three (3) packages per patient per calendar quarter for the first three (3) quarters of the year:
January 1 – March 31
April 1 – June 30
July 1 - September 30

During the fourth (4th) quarter of the year, incoming packages are limited to four (4) vendor packages.

Not all items in catalogs offered by an approved vendor are permitted. All items must comply with current hospital policies. No upgraded items will be allowed as replacement by the Vendor/ Businesses/ Organizations. (08/23/00)

Items will only be accepted if shipped directly to DSH - Atascadero from one of the approved Vendors/ Businesses/ Organizations. Patients or their families/friends can order approved items from these Vendors/Businesses/Organizations.

Prior to submission, orders for Vendor/ Businesses/Organizations purchases will be reviewed by the Unit Supervisor/ designee for appropriateness and compliance with policy. It is the responsibility of the individual to order approved items only. All items will be opened in the Package Room, in accordance with existing policies and procedures. Items that have “refrigerate after opening” and/or are received in contraband containers will NOT be accepted.

Inappropriate, non-approved, or contraband items will be returned to the Vendor/ Business/Organization at the patient’s expense. Patient will have 45 days to mail item/items. Patient does have the option to donate non-allowable items or to discard. Remember, only items that are on the **DSH – Atascadero Incoming Approved Items List and NOT contraband** may be ordered and sent into DSH - Atascadero. Christian Book Distributors is now included in the Approved Religious Vendors List.

II. Only “allowable religious items” may be ordered by patients (See AD 618.1 Religious/Spiritual Items). No contraband items may be ordered or received.

Processing chain:

A. A patient who wants to purchase a spiritual item contacts his religious leader and/or chaplain, and together they review the items in their approved Catalog(s).

B. When an item is selected, the order form is completed and the chaplain gives it to the Chief of Recovery and Mall Services or his designee for review.

C. The reviewed order form is sent to the patient’s Unit Supervisor who assists him to complete the Withdrawal of Client’s Funds form, send it to the DSH - Atascadero Trust Office, and notify the Patient Package Room to expect the order.

D. When the item arrives in the Patient Package Room, the Package Room staff notify the unit and patient for pick-up.
